A message from Andy Harrington, Executive Director
Canadian Foodgrains Bank:

The 2022 Global Report on Food Crises (GRFC) that was recently released paints a difficult picture. The GRFC focuses on acute hunger, at Integrated Food Security Phase classification (IPC) phase 3 and above. In 2021, 193 million people were acutely food insecure and in need of urgent assistance across 53 countries and territories, an increase of 40 million from 2020. Almost 70 percent of the total number above were found in 10 food crisis countries and territories: the Democratic Republic of the Congo, Afghanistan, Ethiopia, Yemen, Northern Nigeria, the Syrian Arab Republic, the Sudan, South Sudan, Pakistan, and Haiti. In seven of these, conflict and insecurity was the primary driver of acute food insecurity. There are 40 million people facing emergency or worse at IPC phase 4 or above across 36 countries.

NCM Canada response to hunger through Canadian Foodgrains Bank.

NCM Canada is supporting food assistance projects in Lebanon and in Afghanistan and a large food security project in Ethiopia.

NCM Canada is funding a three year agriculture and livelihoods program in both Nepal and Bangladesh, helping subsistence farmers and day labourers to increase their production of food; empowering women by providing skill training and training in nutrition, sanitation, and health; and helping to organize farmers and link them with markets for their products.
